**PRE-FINANCIAL MATHEMATICS AND STATISTICS MAJOR, B.S. – 2009-2010**

Students must complete all pre-major courses in Areas A and B with a 2.5 or higher UC grade point average. Courses in Area C must be completed with a grade of “C” or higher. Entry into the pre-major does not guarantee admission to full major status. While completing this required preparation, students will be classified as pre-majors.

**PRE-MAJOR UNITS YET TO COMPLETE**

- A. Economics 1 and 2 ..... 8 \_\_\_\_\_
- B. Math 3A-B-C, 5A-B-C, 8 ..... 29 \_\_\_\_\_
- C. One course from Computer Science 8, 16, or Engineering 3 ..... 3-4 \_\_\_\_\_

Upon satisfactory completion of the pre-major requirements, the student must complete a change of major petition in the Department of Mathematics, 6607 South Hall, or in the Department of Statistics and Applied Probability, 5607A South Hall, and obtain the appropriate signatures.

**MAJOR REGULATIONS**

- PREREQUISITES** ..... Check the *General Catalog* for the prerequisites to all listed courses.
- P/NP GRADING OPTION** ..... Not allowed for major courses (Prep or UD major), including courses applied to the major from other departments.
- SUBSTITUTIONS** ..... In the major requirements permissible only by petition to the department chair and dean.
- RESIDENCE REQUIREMENTS** ..... At least 20 UD units in major while in residence at UCSB.
- G.P.A. REQUIREMENTS** ..... At least 2.0 overall UC average in **all** upper-division major courses **and all** courses (Prep and UD) for the major, including courses in excess of minimum requirements.
- DOUBLE MAJORS** ..... With the approval of each department chairperson, up to a total of 8 units may be applied simultaneously to both UD majors.
